This pre-election celebration is an opportunity to meet prospective Democratic candidates, Democratic party leadership, local community organizers, dedicated volunteers and other Democrats.

We are all eager to hold on to the **Presidency** and the **Democratic seats** we currently have and target electing a Democrat for the **San Diego Mayor's office** and a new **Democratic Representative to Congress**, saving "Bye, Bye to Bilbray."
